## Re: Case 19-G-0309 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY for Gas Service.

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the Order Approving Joint Proposal, as Modified, and Imposing Additional Requirements (issued and effective August 2021) in Case 19-G-0309 (the "Order"), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY ("KEDNY") submit for filing the gas tariff leaves listed on Attachments A. Ordering Clause No. 5 directed the Company to file, on not less than one day's notice, tariff revisions to effectuate the provisions adopted by the Order to take effect on a temporary basis on September 1, 2021. The Company is filing as Attachment B their revised Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") revenue targets and Non-Firm Demand Response revenue targets to reflect recovery of \$2.5 million annually per company through the Rate Adjustment Clause ("RAC") mechanism rather than base delivery rates in Rate Year 2 and Rate Year 3 as required by the Order. The Company is also filing as Attachment C the RAC unit rate calculation, by service classification, to take effect as of September 1, 2021.

Per Ordering Clause No. 8, the requirements of § 66(12) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR 270.70 that newspaper publication be completed before the effective dates of the amendments were waived with respect to the Rate Year One and Rate Year Two tariff revisions. The Company, however, are directed to file with the Commission, within six weeks of the effective date of the amendments, proof that notice to the public of the changes set forth in the amendments and their effective date have been published once a week for four successive weeks in one or more newspapers having general circulation in the service territory.

This filing is made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic filing system) to the Commission's Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR, Appendix 7-H). As required by Ordering Clause No. 6, the active parties to the above-captioned cases have been served this filing via electronic mail.
