Purpose of Filing

The Companies are submitting tariff revisions in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order.

Overview

The Order requires the Companies to continue the existing statewide exemptions from standby rates for residential and small commercial customers, as well as technologies identified in Public Service Law Section 66-j and Section 66-l. Exemptions for Designated Technologies shall continue until May 31, 2023. Additionally, the Companies have removed the exemptions for Combined Heat and Power (CHP) units put in service after May 31, 2021, as directed in the Order. NYSEG and RG&E are also correcting the Rule Numbers for corresponding designated technologies that can opt into Standby Service.

Newspaper Publication

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 6 of the Order, newspaper publication in accordance with Public Service Law 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR 720-8.1 is waived.
