RE: Case 17-E-0238 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a/ National Grid for Electric Service

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consistent with the New York State Public Service Commission's ("Commission") *Order Establishing Rate Year 4 Delivery Rates for Specific Service Classifications* (the "Order") issued on March 19, 2021 in Case 17-E-0238, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the "Company") hereby submits revised tariff leaves for PSC No. 214 Schedule for Electric Service – Outdoor Lighting, listed in Appendix A hereto, to become effective on a temporary basis on April 1, 2021.

On October 8, 2020, the Company filed a petition (the "Petition") in Case 17-E-0238 to establish Rate Year 4 ("RY4") delivery rates for all PSC No. 214 service classifications to become effective on April 1, 2021. The Petition was necessary due to the omission of those rates from the Joint Proposal adopted in the *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plan* (the "Rate Order"), issued on March 15, 2018 under the same case number. The Rate Order requires that the Company make a tariff filing setting forth revised rates for each rate year on not less than 30 days' notice prior to the start of that rate year. On February 26, 2021, the Company made this compliance filing for RY4, which set forth RY4 rates for those service classifications for which rates were contained in the Rate Order's Joint Proposal. In order to incorporate the RY4 rates approved by this Order, the Company files further tariff revisions to incorporate the Petition's RY4 rates.

Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order directed the utilities to file tariff amendments on no less than five days' notice to become effective on April 1, 2021, on a temporary basis. The Company will complete detailed communication outreach to customers and therefore, per Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order, requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived.

Attachment 1 contains the Company's redlined tariff leaves showing where the changes have occurred. Any questions regarding this filing may be directed to the undersigned.
