Statements GSC-243 and FTR-272, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 6, 11, 12 and 13 will become effective on April 1, 2021. Statement FTR-272 also reflects the Weighted Average Cost of Capacity and the WBS Weighted Average Cost of Storage. Statements IGR-273 and ITR-266, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 8 and 9, will become effective on March 31, 2021.

Pursuant to Order in Case 17-G-0460 dated June 14, 2018, a new Gas Miscellaneous Charge mechanism was implemented to address the recovery and refund of new initiatives including interruptible refunds or surcharges applicable to Service Classification No. 11 customers, Gas Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("RAM") and Earnings Adjustment Mechanism ("EAM") incentives. Statement MISC-35 will become effective on April 1, 2021.

Appendix 7-H related to GSC-243 has been filed with trade secret status directly with the records access officer. Appendix 7-H and Exhibit I related to GSC-243 have also been sent directly to the Commission's Staff.
