Purpose of Filing

The Companies are submitting tariff revisions in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order implementing modifications to the Value of Distributed Energy Resources Value Stack compensation.

Overview

In accordance with the Order, the Companies have revised their tariffs to implement modifications to the calculation of the Community Credit component of the Value Stack. The Order authorizes the Companies to reallocate capacity from closed tranches where available capacity remained due to projects being cancelled and assign that capacity to a new Community Credit Tranche ("Community Credit Tranche 2"). The Companies will continue this reallocation process until November 1, 2020, or until the Community Credit Tranche 2 is full and cancellations have slowed such that there are no cancellations for one calendar month. The Community Credit component rate for the reassigned capacity to Community Credit Tranche 2 will be \$0.02 per kWh.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Order, newspaper publication in accordance with Public Service Law 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR 720-8.1 is waived.
