**RE: Case 19-E-0723, Common Community Distributed Generation Projects between
Electric and PASNY Customers**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Electric Tariff leaf identified below is filed to become effective on April 1, 2020.

Reason for Filing

This filing is made pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Approving Tariff Amendments*, issued and effective March 19, 2020 (the “Order”) in Case 19-E-0723. In the Order, the Commission approved the Company’s November 12, 2019, January 27, 2020, and February 25, 2020 filings to allow NYPA customers to participate in CDG projects with NYPA and non-NYPA customers, facilitating the development of additional distributed generation and allowing both NYPA and non-NYPA customers to benefit through shared participation in that distributed generation. The Order directed the Company to revise Leaves 253.4.3 and 253.5 to incorporate provisions previously approved by the Commission in Case 15-E-0751.¹

Tariff Changes

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is incorporating revisions to Leaves 253.4.3 and 253.5 that were previously approved by the Commission in Case 15-E-0751. On Leaf 253.4.3, the numbering for General Rule 24.H.4.f.ii. was correct in the Company's November 12, 2019 filing. However, it was inadvertently changed to Section 24.H.4.f.i. in the filing pursuant to Case 15-E-0751. The Company is correcting the numbering in this filing.

Conclusion and Notice

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2, the Company is filing its tariff modifications on not less than one day's notice to become effective on April 1, 2020.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 4, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
