Addendum No. 10 – SIR To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity Effective: February 3, 2020

This filing is being made in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order, which directed the utilities to make tariff filings to incorporate into their electric tariffs the revised Standard Interconnection Requirements and to remove any inconsistent tariff provisions. This tariff amendment is to become effective on not less than one day's notice, to take effect on February 3, 2020, based on the extension granted by the Secretary on December 30, 2019.

In addition, per Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order, the requirements of Public Services Law Section 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 related to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments are waived.
