Reason for Filing and Tariff Changes

The Commission in its Order Modifying Standardized Interconnection Requirements, issued and effective December 13, 2019, in Case 19-E-0566 (the “Order”) directed the major electric utilities to incorporate into their electric tariffs the revised Standardized Interconnection Requirements (“SIR”) as shown in Appendix A of the Order, and to remove any inconsistent tariff provisions. Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing the Commission’s revised SIR as Tariff Addendum SIR-13.

Conclusion and Notice

Addendum SIR-13 is being filed on not less than one day's notice, to become effective on or before February 3, 2020.¹ As specified in Ordering Clause 3 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication.

¹ Ordering Clause 1 of the Order directed that the changes should be filed on not less than one days' notice to become effective on or before January 1, 2019. On December 30, 2019, the Commission granted the request of Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation, O&R, and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to file their tariff changes on not less than one days' notice to become effective February 3, 2020.
