Relating to Billing Information for Residential Rental Premises**

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment, identified below, to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester, which is proposed to become effective on July 1, 2020.

Reason for Filing

This filing is made pursuant to the Commission’s Notice of Tariff Filings Due to Amendment of Public Service Law in Case 20-M-0029¹ issued January 22, 2020 (the “Notice”). The Notice directed each utility to file tariff modifications as necessary to effectuate PSL §66-p.

Tariff Changes

Pursuant to the Notice, the Company has added the following language to General Rule 17.4 of the Electric Tariff.

Upon written request from a prospective tenant, the Company will provide, at no cost, the total electric charges incurred at the prospective residential rental premises for the life of

the premises, or the preceding two-year period, whichever is shorter. The Company will provide such information to the prospective landlord, or other authorized person, within ten days of receipt of the written request.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by the Notice, the tariff amendment is filed by February 21, 2020, to become effective on July 1, 2020. Since this tariff filing is merely serving to effectuate a change in public service law, the Company requests a waiver of newspaper publication.
