RE: Tenant Energy Bill Data Law Change

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Enclosed is the following tariff leaf transmitted for filing by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("Company") in connection with the newly amended Public Service Law §66-p (PSL §66-p).

Leaf No. 41 Revision No. 1
To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity
Effective: July 1, 2020

PSL §66-p makes gas and electric billing information for residential rental premises available upon request. This new addition directs "Every Gas Corporation, Electric Corporation, and Municipality shall make available to any landlord or lessor of residential rental premises, within ten days of receipt of a written request therefor from any prospective tenant or lessee thereof, prior to the commencement of tenancy or execution of a lease, information consisting of the charges incurred at such premises for gas or electric service or both for the life of the dwelling unit or the preceding two-year period, whichever is shorter. Such information shall be identified solely by the address of the dwelling unit, and no other information identifying the owner, lessee, or other occupant of the dwelling unit shall be utilized for, or made available in connection with, the furnishing or billing information pursuant to this section."

Since these tariff filings are merely serving to effectuate a change in the NY Public Service Law, the Company, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-p is requested for this filing. A further revised redline and clean version of the tariff leaf is attached.
