Dear Secretary Burgess:

Pursuant to the Public Service Commission's Notice issued on January 22, 2020 in Case 20-M-0029, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files amended tariff leaves to become effective July 1, 2020.

<u>P.S.C. No. 12 – Gas</u> Original Leaf No. 11.1

<u>P.S.C. No. 15 – Electric</u> 3rd Revised Leaf No. 19.2

The purpose of this filing is to effectuate changes to the Public Service Law §66-p (Chapter 705 of the Laws of 2019) which will become effective April 18, 2020. The tariff amendments specify that the Company shall provide landlord or prospective lessor of residential premises information consisting of the charges incurred at such premises for gas and electric service if requested by any prospective tenant free of charge.

The Company requests that the requirement of § 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication be waived since these tariff filings are serving to effectuate a change in Public Service Law and customers would otherwise be in contact with the Company to request this information.
