Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation, d/b/a National Grid (the "Company") submits the following revised P.S.C. No. 214 – Outdoor Lighting Tariff (the "Lighting Tariff") leaf for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission"):

Thirteenth Revised Leaf No. 41

To PSC No. 214 Electricity

Effective: March 25, 2020

The purpose of this filing, which is of a housekeeping nature, is to remove the pricing exceptions for the City of Syracuse (the "City"). In the *Order Approving Transfer of Street Lighting Facilities to the City of Syracuse*, issued October 17, 2019 in Case 19-E-0468, the Commission approved the sale of street lighting facilities to the City, including street lighting facilities identified on leaf 41 of the Tariff as "State of New York, Syracuse Armory," for which the City assumed responsibility prior to the sale. The Company and the City closed the transaction on December 20, 2019. With the transfer of the street lighting assets complete, the City moved from Lighting Tariff Service Classification ("S.C.") No. 2 to S.C. No. 3 (energy only), eliminating the pricing exceptions. Attachment 1 included with this filing contains redlined leaf showing this change.

Because of the housekeeping nature of this filing, the Company requests waiver of the statutory requirements required under the State Administrative Procedures Act for this leaf to become effective on March 25, 2020. Furthermore, because of the limited customer impact created by the changes, the Company also requests waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720.8.
