In accordance with the New York Public Service Commission's Order Authorizing the Clean Energy Fund Framework ("Order") issued January 21, 2016 and Order Authorizing Utility-Administered Energy Efficiency Portfolio Budgets and Targets For 2019 - 2020 issued March 15, 2018 in the above-referenced cases, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the "Company") hereby submits the following statement to become effective on January 1, 2020:

Statement of System Benefits Charge No. 23 To Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 12-GAS.

The purpose of this filing is to update The Clean Energy Fund ("CEF") and the Energy Efficiency Surcharge ("EES") for calendar year 2020. Attachment 1 contains the calculations used to develop the CEF surcharge rate. Attachment 2 contains the calculation used to develop the EES surcharge rate. The CEF and EES factors will be set forth on the Statement of System Benefits Charge and will be included in the calculation of the total System Benefits Charge included on the customer's bill.
