On May 2, 2019, the Company filed a petition for authorization to adjust the methodology used to make annual changes to low-income discount amounts, specifically implementing a 20 percent limit on reductions in discount levels from one year to the other.

On October 18, 2019, the Commission issued the Order approving the Company’s request. Ordering paragraph 3 directs the Company to file revised EAC statements. This filing is in compliance with that directive.
