Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing revised addenda in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 2 of the Order. The revisions shall provide that no fee for termination or early cancellation shall be assessed by an Energy Services Company ("ESCO") in the event the customer is deceased before the end of their contract term and that ESCO marketing representatives' wear identification that provides their first name and an employee identification number for privacy reasons.
