Effective: December 22, 2019

This filing complies with Ordering Clause No. 11 of the Initial Order, requiring the Company to develop a surcharge mechanism for use by all non-System Benefits Charge paying customers for a period of one year beginning January 1, 2020. The tariff revisions are required to be filed by November 1, 2019 per the Errata Notice to enable this surcharge on ten days’ notice.

A redlined version of the revised tariff leaves is provided in Appendix A. The derivation of the surcharge rate is provided in Appendix B.

The requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 related to newspaper publication has been waived per Order 1, Ordering Clause 13.
