Statements GSC-221 and FTR-250, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 6, 11, 12 and 13 will become effective on June 3, 2019. Statement FTR-250 also reflects the Weighted Average Cost of Capacity and the WBS Weighted Average Cost of Storage. Statements IGR-251 and ITR-243, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 8 and 9, will become effective on May 31, 2019.

Pursuant to Order in Case 17-G-0460 dated June 14, 2018, a new Gas Miscellaneous Charge mechanism was implemented to address the recovery and refund of new initiatives including interruptible refunds or surcharges applicable to Service Classification No. 11 customers. Statement MISC-11, applicable to Service Classification No. 11 will become effective on June 3, 2019.

Pursuant to the provisions noted in the Company's tariff and in accordance with NYCRR §720-6.5, the Company had filed an interim surcharge of \$0.18500 per Ccf as a result of additional spot and peaking purchases during the months of December, January, February and March. The purpose of this interim surcharge was to minimize the possibility of a large under-collection at the end of the reconciliation period. Based on the current status of collections this interim surcharge will no longer remain in effect.

Appendix 7-H related to GSC-221 has been filed with trade secret status directly with the records access officer. Appendix 7-H and Exhibit I related to GSC-221 have also been sent directly to the Commission's Staff.
