Enclosed is the following tariff leaf transmitted for filing by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("Company") in connection with the above Order issued by the Public Service Commission on May 20, 2019 regarding Customer Consent to Contact ("the Order").

Effective: June 1, 2019

This filing is made in compliance with the Order, which directed the Company to file tariff revisions setting forth the customer's consent, upon receiving utility service from the Company, to receive autodialed and prerecorded/automated calls and texts that are closely related to their utility service, such as, among other things, a service outage or warning about potential service interruptions due to weather conditions. The tariff amendment also describes how customers may opt-out of receiving these autodialed and prerecorded/automated calls and texts.

These proposed tariff revisions are in compliance with: (i) Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, which directs the Company to file revised tariff leaves on not less than one day's notice to become effective on June 1, 2019.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause 3, newspaper publication required by PSL § 66-12 (b) and 16 NYCRR § 720-8.1 of the proposed tariff amendments have been waived.
