**RE: Case No. 16-M-0330, Petition of CTIA – The
Wireless Association to Initiate a Proceeding to
Update and Clarify Wireless Pole Attachment
Protections**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Tariff Leaf, which is identified below, makes changes to Rider K. The Tariff Leaf has an effective date of August 1, 2019:

Reason for Filing

This filing is made pursuant to the Commission’s Order Approving Petition in Part and Continuing Proceeding (the “Order”), issued and effective March 14, 2019 in the above referenced proceeding. The Order directed all electric and telephone utilities subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission to file tariff amendments setting rates for new wireless pole attachments.

Tariff Changes

The Company proposes to update Rider K – Pole Attachment Rental Rate, to reflect charges that would be applicable to both span wire attachments and to establish the charge

applicable to new wireless pole attachments. The Company has calculated the charge for span wire pole attachments to be \$35.66 per attachment per year¹ and the charge for new wireless pole attachments to be \$35.66 multiplied by the number of feet occupied. The number of feet occupied: (1) will reflect the overall length of the equipment and mounting hardware, plus six inches, rounded to the next whole foot; and (2) will exclude conduits, risers, and electrical meters.

Consistent with the Order, the rate used to determine the annual pole attachment charge was formulated using the Federal Communications Commission's cable formula for horizontal cable attachments and reflects the 2018 Con Edison pole attachment cost. Work papers detailing the computation of the revised rate used to determine the annual pole attachment charge are enclosed.²

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Tariff 90 days after the date of the Order, *i.e.*, June 12, 2019, to become effective on August 1, 2019. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 5 of the Order, the Commission has waved the requirements for newspaper publication. Additionally, a copy of this filing will be sent to all cable television companies and telecommunication carriers that currently attach facilities to the Company's poles.

¹ The current span wire pole attachment rate of \$16.15 per attachment per year has been in effect since November 1, 2011.

² The Company has used the pre-tax rate of return as adopted in Case No. 16-E-0060 and adjusted to reflect the effect of the federal Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017, for the calculation of the span wire and wireless pole attachment rates.
