RE: Case Nos. 14-E-0423 and 15-E-0191, Proceeding on Motion of the Commission to Develop Dynamic Load Management Programs

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company" or "O&R") hereby submits for electronic filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") 3rd Revised Leaf No. 156.10 and 4th Revised Leaf No. 157.9 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY (the "Electric Tariff").

Reason for Filing

Ordering Clause 1 of the Commission's <u>Order Adopting Program Changes and Making Other Findings</u>, issued and effective March 18, 2019, in Case Nos. 14-E-0423 and 15-E-0191 (the "March Order"), directed the electric distribution utilities to file, by May 1, 2019, tariff amendments to implement changes to their distribution level demand response programs for the 2019 capability period required in the body of the March Order.

In the March Order the Commission approved the Company's proposed changes¹ to its distribution level demand response programs for the 2019 capability period. The Company hereby files its compliance tariff revisions for two of its existing distribution-level demand response programs: the Commercial System Relief Program and the Distribution Load Relief Program. These programs are included in the Electric Tariff under Riders E and F, respectively.

Tariff Changes

The Company has eliminated language from Section E of the Reservation Payment Option section of Riders E and F to remove true-up provisions for existing program Aggregators. The Company has also clarified that existing Direct Participant customers are not subject to the true-up. Moving forward, true-ups will only occur for new program Direct Participants or Aggregators.
