Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Electric Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The Company's tariff leaf, identified below, is issued to become effective on June 1, 2019.

## **Reason for Filing**

The Commission's <u>Order Approving Tariff Amendments on a Permanent Basis</u> ("Order"), issued April 26, 2019, in Cases 16-E-0060, 16-G-0061 and 14-M-0565 directed the Company to file tariff amendments to clarify the eligibility requirements for the Company's low income program tiers.

## **Tariff Changes**

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing tariff changes on Leaf 255 of the Electric Tariff as described below:

- Modified the definition of add-on benefits to clearly reflect that an add-on benefit requires an incremental payment in addition to a regular HEAP benefit.
- Clarified the eligibility requirements for the various tiered offerings.

## **Conclusion and Notice**

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Electric Tariff on not less than 10 days' notice to become effective on June 1, 2019. As specified in Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
