This filing is made in compliance with the Order, which directed the Company to file further revisions as discussed in the body of this Order clarifying that a meter read fee will not be charged to customers where the customer has a meter the Company can read without sending personnel to the customer’s premises.

These proposed tariff revisions are in compliance with: (i) Ordering Clause 4 of the Order, which directs the Company to file on not less than five days’ notice to commence on May 1, 2019.

Also, in accordance with Ordering Clause 6 of this order, the requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16 NYCRR 720.8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments have been waived.
