Effective: 05/01/2019

The Company originally filed Leaf 62 to include language regarding a customer's ability to request that their meters be read on a date other than the customer's regularly scheduled meter read date at the associated fee. After an initial filing of the second revision to Leaf 62 on November 8, 2018, the Company is further revising this tariff leaf to clarify that subject to certain conditions, when a customer is disconnecting service and so requests, the Company is required to provide an actual meter read within 48 hours of the customer's request.

Given the newly enacted statute went into effect immediately upon being signed by the Governor on August 24, 2018, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's Regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
