Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The revised Electric Tariff Leaves, which are identified below, are filed to become effective on May 1, 2019.

Reason for Filing

This filing is made pursuant to the Commission’s Order on Value Stack Eligibility Expansion and Other Matters, issued and effective September 12, 2018 (the “Order”) in Cases 15-E-0751 and 15-E-0082.

Tariff Changes

The Company has modified Section F of Rider R, Remote Net Metering and Community Distributed Generation, to state that Remote Net Metering (“RNM”) and Community Distributed Generation (“CDG”) are applicable to residential Customers with Farm Operations and non-residential Customers that have either Stand-alone Electric Energy Storage or Hybrid Electric Energy Storage systems. RNM Host Accounts or CDG Host Accounts served under Rider R with these Electric Energy Storage systems will take service under the Value Stack Tariff. The Company has also amended Section 4 of Application Form G to add Stand-alone and Hybrid

Energy Storage to the list of technologies allowed to participate in RNM provided the Customer is a residential Customer with a farm operation or is a non-residential customer.

Conclusion and Notice

The Company is filing these changes on not less than 30 days' notice. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
