Enclosed herewith are the following materials, issued and transmitted for filing for the Village of Sherburne ("Village"), in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("Commission").

1. Revised Tariff leaf for PSC No. 1, Electricity, containing provisions to govern the rates and conditions of service for demand metered general service in Service Classification No. 3:

Revised Leaf No. 8, Revision 5

This revision is issued as of April 5, 2019 and is proposed to be effective August 15, 2019.

The above proposed revision to Service Classification No. 3 is a net neutral revenue adjustment. It will increase the energy charge (from \$0.0089 per kWh to \$0.0109 per kWh) while reducing the demand charge (from \$5.57 per kW to \$5.05 per kW).

The Village of Sherburne is an equal opportunity provider and employer. In addition, the proposed amendment is the second of a five year phase-in of the S.C. No. 3 energy rate. The phase-in is meant to establish an energy rate that is at or above the base fuel cost for S.C. No. 3, while limiting customer specific bill impacts to approximately 5%.

In compliance with the newspaper publication requirements of PSL § 66(12)(b), the proposed tariff change will be published in the local newspaper for four consecutive weeks following the date of issuance.
