Electric Generator Revenue ("EGR") Reconciliation for Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Brooklyn Union Gas Company, d/b/a National Grid ("the Company") hereby submits its Statement of Electric Generator Revenue "EGR" Reconciliation No. 2 ("Statement") in compliance with Rule 53 of PSC No. 12 Gas Tariff. The Company has performed a reconciliation of its Electric Generator Revenue Mechanism for the period January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018. In addition, the EGR Reconciliation includes the remaining imbalance for the calendar year 2017 reconciliation.

Effective March 1, 2019 through February 28, 2020, the following Electric Generator Revenue Reconciliation will be implemented:

- Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4A-CNG, 4B, 7, 17 and 21: (\$0.0024) per therm credit.
