Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Electric Tariff Leaves, which are identified below, are filed to become effective on March 1, 2019:

Reason for Filing

This filing is being made pursuant to the Commission’s *Order Establishing Framework For Direct Current Fast Charging Infrastructure Program*, issued and effective February 7, 2019, in Case 18-E-0138 (the “Order”). The Order required the Company to file revisions to the

Business Incentive Rate (“BIR”) under Rider J of the Electric Tariff. The Order adopted the Consensus Proposal¹ filed on November 21, 2018 in this proceeding with modifications.

Tariff Changes

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is making the following changes to the Electric Vehicle (“EV”) Quick Charging Station Program under Rider J of the Electric Tariff:

- Governmental entities will be permitted to participate;
- The requirement for program participants to obtain economic incentives has been eliminated;
- Applications for service must include proof of building permit and proof of payment of excess distribution facilities, if applicable; and
- The term of the program has been extended until December 31, 2025.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 10 of the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Electric Tariff within one day’s notice to become effective on March 1, 2019. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 13 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication of these changes.
