The statement set forth below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or the "Company") on January 18, 2021 to become effective February 2, 2021.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electric

Statement of Electric Vehicle Make-Ready EVS-1

Pursuant to Order in Case 18-E-0138 dated July 16, 2020, the Company will implement a new Electric Vehicle Make-Ready ("EVMR") Program factor designed to recover the following costs as addressed by the Commission in Case 18-E-0138:

- (a) Utility-Owned Make-Ready Work
- (b) Customer-Owned Make-Ready Work
- (c) Other Programs
- (d) Make-Ready Implementation Costs

The EVS factor will be effective the first billing batch in February 2021 to refund or recover the costs of this program in a new Electric Vehicle Make-Ready surcharge statement, updated and filed annually with rates rolling up into the existing Miscellaneous Charges.

In addition, because the first calendar year is truncated (i.e., date of Order July 16, 2020 through December 31, 2020) and there is a small amount of program costs incurred by the Company to date, the initial statement filed in 2021 will contain \$0 rates. Any costs incurred by the Company in CY2020 would be rolled into the CY2021 costs and included in the 2022 statement.
