Re: Case 18-E-0138 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission Regarding Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment and Infrastructure.

Dear Secretary Phillips:

New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”), (together the “Companies”), are submitting this filing in compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission’s (the “Commission”) Order Establishing Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Make-Ready Program and Other Programs, issued and effective on July 16, 2020 (the “Order”), in the above-referenced proceeding. The tariff leaves, listed in Attachment 1, will become effective on January 1, 2021.

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing amendments to its tariffs in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 5 of the Order to effectuate the cost recovery associated with the make-ready programs administered by the Companies or by NYSERDA.

Overview

The Companies and NYSERDA are implementing electric vehicle (“EV”) make-ready programs to support the development and deployment of the infrastructure necessary to support EV charging stations.

The Companies are filing tariff revisions to implement a surcharge to recover the costs associated with the make-ready programs. The Companies will recover program costs through an EV Make-Ready Surcharge that will apply to all customers that take delivery service from the Companies¹. The surcharge will be allocated to all customer classes based on delivery service revenues. The surcharge will be on a per kWh basis for non-demand customers; on a per kW basis for demand-billed customers; and on a per As-Used basis for Standby customers. The EV

¹ A customer that qualifies for the Excelsior Jobs Program is exempt from paying the EV Make-Ready Surcharge.



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Make-Ready Surcharge collections will be reconciled on an annual basis; any over- or under-collections will be credited or surcharged to customers.

The EV Make-Ready Surcharge will be included in the Transition Charge on customer bills. An Electric Vehicle Make-Ready ("EVMR") Statement will be filed with the Commission on not less than 15 days' notice to be effective on February 1.

Newspaper Publication

The Companies will complete newspaper publication in accordance with the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1.
