Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with General Information Sections 42.C of P.S.C. No. 12 - Gas, the Statement listed below is filed by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") to become effective January 5, 2021.

P.S.C. No. 12 – Gas

Statement of Systems Benefit Charge SBC - 25

Pursuant to the Company's tariff, the Company routinely files a Statement of System Benefits Charge ("SBC Statement") in December to be effective with the first billing batch of the Company's January billing cycle. The purpose of this filing is to correct the previously filed effective date of 1/4/21 to 1/5/21. The date of 1/4/21 conflicts with our processing. Also, to incorporate in the current collection factor the current annual assessment amounts and a reconciliation of recoveries (eleven months actual, one month forecast) with the prior year's requirements. It should be noted 2020 was the last year of authorized collections per Appendix I of January 1, 2016 Order in Case 14-M-0094 and as such the 2021 factor is a credit reflecting only a reconciliation of prior periods.
