Dear Secretary Phillips:

The enclosed tariff leaf, issued by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG" or the "Company"), is transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of Appendix 7-H (electronic tariff filing system) to the New York State Public Service Commission's ("Commission") Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR Appendix 7-H). This leaf is proposed to become effective on April 1, 2021.

P.S.C. No. 88 – Gas, Schedule for Gas Service Leaf No. 12.3, Revision 6

Purpose and Overview of Filing

The Company is proposing a revision to its tariff to clarify the geographical areas where ESCOs of daily metered transportation customers will be assessed a capacity surcharge.

Currently, the tariff states that ESCOs of transportation customers or Direct Customers in the Goshen Area, Champlain Area, Plattsburgh District and Mechanicville District shall be assessed a capacity surcharge to reflect costs incurred by the Company to transport customers' supplies on intermediary local distribution companies and intrastate pipelines. The Company's Gas Transportation Operating Procedures ("GTOP") Manual includes this same language as well as the specific release points.

The Company is proposing that the tariff refer to the Company's GTOP Manual where specific areas can be listed for the applicability of the capacity surcharge to ESCOs. This will allow for a more efficient process if specific areas are added or removed from the list of areas where the capacity surcharge is assessed¹.

¹ Changes to the GTOP Manual are and will continue to be communicated 30 days prior to their effective date.



The Company has included the relevant GTOP Manual updates as an Attachment to this filing.

Publication

The Company respectfully requests the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication be waived as these changes will not affect the majority of the Company's customers.
