**Case 20-W-0096 - Compliance Tariff Filing by New York American Water Company, Inc. Pursuant to Commission Order issued February 6, 2020 in Case 16-W-0259 Implementing the Prorated Tariff Language, Pursuant to Ordering Clause No. 2, effective July 1, 2020**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

On February 21, 2020, New York American Water Company, Inc. filed the following Tariff, P.S.C. No. 5 – Water tariff leaves with an effective date of July 1, 2020, reflecting proration tariff language changes made pursuant to ordering paragraph number 2 of the New York State Public Service Commission Order Approving Final Implementation Plan With Modifications (“Implementation Order”) issued and effective February 6, 2020, in Case 16-W-0259, which filing was designated Case 20-W-0096:

- Original Leaf No. 18.1;
- Second Revised Leaf No. 18;
- Fourth Revised Leaves Nos. 61 through 64; and
- Fifth Revised Leaf No. 69.

New York American Water respectfully requests a postponement of the effective date of the proration tariff language changes from July 1, 2020 to September 1, 2020 and hereby submits Supplement No. 7. We believe that postponement of the effective date of these language changes to September 1, 2020, the same effective date of the Rate Year 4 tariff changes, will be less administratively burdensome, and create less confusion on those tariff leaves where the proposed changes intersect.

New York American Water also requests that Supplement No. 7 be allowed to go into effect on short notice, to take effect on July 1, 2020, and requests a waiver of Commission rules and regulations regarding newspaper publication for the supplement.
