In accordance with the Public Service Commission's <u>Order Establishing Rate Plan</u>, and New York State Electric & Gas Corporation's ("NYSEG" or "the Company") tariff schedule, PSC No. 90, NYSEG hereby files the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment Statement to be effective May 23, 2020.

The Company filed an interim adjustment to the RDM on December 19, 2019. As noted in the December filing, the interim RDM Adjustment was to be in effect through April 30, 2020, in accordance with its tariff. The Company stopped billing the interim RDM adjustment as of April 30, 2020. For clarity, the Company is filing revisions to remove the price for the interim RDM from the statements.
