As per the order issued in Case 09-M-0311, issued June 18, 2014, Ordering Clause No. 1 directed the Company to file annual changes to their Temporary State Assessment Surcharge tariff statements to become effective on 15 days' notice. The Company is proposing revising the above leaf to remove 15 business days to 15 day's notice in accordance with this order.
