RE: Cases 14-E-0151/14-E-0422 – Order Raising Net Metering Minimum Caps, Requiring Tariff Revisions, Making Other Findings, and Establishing Further Procedures

Dear Secretary Burgess:

The enclosed leaf, issued by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“National Grid”), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”).

Seventh Revised Leaf 198

To PSC No. 220 Electricity

Effective: May 4, 2015

On December 15, 2014, the Commission issued the above order directing the major electric utilities to make tariff amendments to increase the minimum limitation for net metering under Public Service §66-j from 3% to 6% of peak load for 2005. The Company is therefore filing Leaf No. 198 increasing the minimum limitation cap to 392,160 kW.

This order also directed the utilities to change: 1) the methodology of issuing excess credits to accounts that are satellite accounts of a non-residential non-demand host customer generator; 2) and waived this crediting methodology for certain grandfathered projects. On February 27, 2015, the Commission issued a further order in this case staying the implementation of these two items. As stated in the order, staying these provisions is an interim measure to better manage the transition in methodology.

Ordering Clause 1 of the December 15 order directed utilities to file tariff changes by December 22, 2014 to become effective January 2, 2015. Subsequently, two related notices were issued by the Commission on December 19, 2014 and February 19, 2015, respectively, ultimately extending the time to file tariff changes to April 3, 2015 to become effective May 4, 2015.

Ordering Clause 3 of this order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of these tariff amendments.
