The Companies are filing tariff amendments in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 3 of the Order to implement changes necessary to effectuate the modifications to the commodity provider switching process.

In accordance with the Order, Energy Service Companies (“ESCOs”) may submit an enrollment by submitting the request five business days prior to the effective date of the switch<sup>1</sup>. The existing enrollment window for gas customers will not change at this time.

Requirements of Public Service Law Section 66 (12) (b) as to newspaper publication of the tariff revisions are waived pursuant to the Ordering Clause No. 3.
