## **Explanation of Filing**

Pursuant to the "make whole" provision of the Joint Proposal ("JP") adopted by the Commission in Case 13-G-0031<sup>1</sup>, the Company will recover or refund any revenue under- or over-collections, including interest, that result from the extension of the suspension period in that case. The JP in the aforementioned case indicated the "make whole" adjustments "will be subject to reconciliation" (JP p. 6). On January 29, 2015 the Company filed the Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 4 to reconcile the difference between "make whole" revenue targets and actual revenues collected from/refunded to customers over the period April – December 2014. The rates designed for Service Classification Nos. 1 and 2 Rider H were designed to be in effect for one month. The Company is hereby filing Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 5 to set the rates for these Service Classes at zero while maintaining the remainder of the rates that became effective February 1, 2015.
