Re: Housekeeping Filing

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) hereby submits for filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) the following tariff leaves reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the “Gas Tariff”).

The tariff leaves, which are identified below, are issued March 14, 2014 and are proposed to become effective on June 1, 2014:

Leaf 166.1, Revision 5 Superseding Revision 4
Leaf 178, Revision 15 Superseding Revision 14

Reason for Filing and Changes Proposed

Pursuant to the Gas Tariff, firm sales and firm transportation customers are subject to a Monthly Rate Adjustment (“MRA”). Currently, the MRA for firm sales customers can be found on the Statement of Monthly Rate Adjustment while the MRA for firm transportation customers can be found on the Statement of Rate for Service Classification No. 9 (or Interruptible Gas Transportation Rate (“ITR”) Statement) which, in addition to the MRA for firm transportation customers, includes rates applicable to interruptible transportation customers. While the total MRA differs for sales and transportation customers, many components of the rate are common between the two. The Company proposes to post the MRA for both firm sales and firm transportation customers on the Statement of Monthly Rate Adjustment, eliminating the MRA from the ITR Statement. The tariff modifications proposed herein effectuate this change by

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modifying tariff language for transportation customers to reference the Statement of Monthly Rate Adjustment.

Attached to this letter is a sample MRA Statement for the month of June 2014, the month the change is proposed to take effect. This sample statement is for illustrative purposes only as many of the rate components for the month of June are not yet known, as indicated by "x.xxxx" on the sample statement.

Conclusion and Notice

The revised versions of the tariff leaves have an issue date of March 14, 2014, and a proposed effective date of June 1, 2014.

The Company respectfully requests waiver of the Commission's requirement for newspaper publication, because these changes have no revenue impact on customers and are of a housekeeping nature.
