The enclosed statements are issued by Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation and transmitted for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission of the State of New York regarding change in adjustments.

Statements GSC-156 and FTR-185, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 6, 12 and 13 will become effective on February 3, 2014. Statement IGR-186, applicable to Service Classification Nos. 8 and 9, will become effective on January 31, 2013.

These statements are revisions to those filed with the Commission on January 28, 2014. Between the filing on January 28, 2014 and as of the close of business on January 29, 2014, the NYMEX settlement price increased over five percent. Pursuant to the tariff, (leaf 68), the Company is authorized to file a new statement on one day's notice to become effective not more than five days after the effective date of the initial statement if the replacement of cost estimates in the initial statement results in a change in the Average Commodity Cost of Gas of more than five percent.
