Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the “Gas Tariff”).

The revised Tariff Leaves, which are identified below, have an effective date of January 15, 2014:

Reason for Filing

This filing is being made pursuant to the Commission’s Order Establishing Policies (“Order”), issued November 18, 2013, in Case 13-M-0061, “In the Matter of Customer Outage Credit Policies and Other Consumer Protection Policies Relating to Prolonged Electric or Natural Gas Service Outages.” As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing amendments to its Gas Tariff to implement the provisions of the Order.

Tariff Changes

Text in General Information Section Nos. III.8.(L) and XI.7. and in Service Classification No. 9 of the Gas Tariff indicating that late payment charges “will” be applied were modified to indicate that such charges “may” be applied.¹

Conclusion and Notice

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, tariff changes are being filed on not less than 30 days’ notice, to become effective on January 15, 2014. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
