Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") hereby
submits for filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") the following
tariff leaves reflecting revisions to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the
"Gas Tariff").

December 1, 2013.

Reason for Filing

This filing is being made in compliance with the Commission's "Order
Approving Tariff Amendment With Modifications", issued and effective November 14,
2013, in Case 13-G-0156 (the "Order"), requiring the Company to file tariff amendments
to reflect modifications to its proposed Area Growth Program filing made on April 1,
2013.

Summary of Tariff Changes

The Commission ordered that certain proposed requirements for participation in the Area Growth Program be removed from leaf 38.1. Specifically, the requirements that a customer (1) “Commit in writing to be a firm gas customer for at least ten (10) years” and (2) “Commit in an affidavit to disconnect oil burning capability” were eliminated from the tariff. The Commission further ordered the Company to supplement its proposed tariff language to include a clarification as to the specific service classes that would qualify for its Area Growth Program. References to Service Classifications 2 Rate II and 3 and their equivalent transportation services under Service Classification 9 were added for clarification. In addition, tariff leaves 235, 244 and 323 were modified to include references to the Area Growth Program section of the tariff in the qualifying Service Classifications.

Notice

In Ordering Clause 5 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication of the tariff amendments.
