Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Tariff Leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of October 1, 2013:

Reason for Filing

A Tariff change is being filed pursuant to the Commission’s Order Distributing Constellation Settlement Refunds to Electric Utility Customers (the “Order”), issued and effective September 20, 2013, in Case 13-E-0232, “In the Matter of the Distribution of Constellation Energy Commodities Group, Inc. Settlement Funds in Accordance with Federal Energy Regulatory Commission Directive.”

Tariff Change

As directed by Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Company is filing a Tariff change to refund to its full service and retail access customers, through the Monthly Adjustment Clause (“MAC”), its customers’ share of the Constellation settlement refund.

¹ Revision No. 1 of Leaf 343 is pending in the Company’s rate case, Case 13-E-0030.

The refund through the MAC will total \$15,134,400 plus any interest disbursement received from NYSERDA.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Company is filing its tariff change on no less than one day's notice, to become effective no later than October 1, 2013. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 3, the Commission has waived the requirement for newspaper publication of this change.
