RE: Case 12-E-0485, Net Metering Limitations

Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") an amendment to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Tariff Leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of July 1, 2013:

Reason for Filing

The Tariff Leaf is being filed pursuant to the Commission's Order Raising Net Metering Limits (the "Order"), issued and effective June 13, 2013, in Case 12-E-0485, "In the Matter of Net Metering Limitations in Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc.'s Service Territory Pursuant to Public Service Law §66-j and §66-l."

The Order directed that all electric utilities file tariff amendments as are necessary to increase the net metering limitations established under Public Service Law §66-j (i.e., 1% of 2005 utility peak load) to 3% of 2005 peak load. This increases the total rated generating capacity eligible for net metering to 332,460 kW for solar, farm waste, micro-CHP, fuel cell, and micro-hydro generating equipment.

Conclusion and Notice

The Tariff Leaf is being filed pursuant to Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, to become effective on July 1, 2013, on not less than one day's notice. Pursuant to Ordering Clause 1, the Commission has waived newspaper publication.
