## RE: Case 11-E-0176, Tariff Changes for the Recharge New York Program

Dear Acting Secretary Cohen:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") an amendment to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Tariff Leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of June 15, 2013:

## **Reason for Filing**

Revision 3 to Tariff Leaf 97 was filed with the Commission on February 1, 2013. Revision 3 to Leaf 97 will become effective on May 20, 2013, pursuant to the Commission's Order issued and effective May 16, 2013, in Case 11-E-0176, regarding the "Tariff Filing by Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. to Modify its Allocation Ratio Under General Rule 11 – Billing Applicable to Service Under Certain Economic Development Programs."

Revision 4 to Tariff Leaf 97 was filed with the Commission on April 24, 2013, pursuant to the Commission's <u>Order Modifying Tariff Requirements Related to the Recharge New York</u> <u>Power Program Act and Initiating Proceeding</u>, issued and effective March 18, 2013, in Cases 11-E-0176 and 13-E-0109. Revision 4 to Leaf 97 became effective on May 1, 2013, pursuant to that Order, prior to the effective date of Revision 3.

This filing is being made to merge the text of Revision 4, which became effective on May 1, 2013, with the text of Revision 3, which will become effective on May 20, 2013.

## Tariff Change

The Company is filing a Revision 5 to Leaf 97 to combines the text of Revisions 3 and 4.

## **Conclusion and Notice**

Because this filing is being made for housekeeping purposes, the Company requests approval on 30 days' notice. Due to its housekeeping nature, the Company respectfully requests waiver of the requirement for newspaper publication.
