Ordering Clause No. 4 directed the Company to file, on not less than one day's notice, tariff revisions necessary to effectuate the provisions adopted by this order to take effect on a temporary basis on April 1, 2013. On March 29, 2013 the Company filed its tariff revisions in compliance with this Order. The above leaf which was included in the filing of March 29, 2013 requires further clarifying revisions. Specifically, Rule 57.1.1 has been amended to revise the language following the asterisk (*) to clarify the applicability of the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") on SC 12 customers.

Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order directed the Company to file revisions to become effective April 1, 2013. The Company respectfully requests that this leaf become effective on one days notice on April 15, 2013. Also Ordering Clause No. 3 of this Order, waived the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of Public Service Law as to newspaper publication for this filing.
