On February 20, 2013, the Commission issued its *Order Authorizing Commercial Submetering and Requiring Rate Cap Bill Calculator* ("the Order") in the above case number.

Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order directed the listed utilities, on or before the sixtieth (60th) day after issuance of the Order, on not less than 30 days notice, to file one or more proposed tariff amendments or riders permitting (1) the purchase of electric service under the service classification that would be applicable if the service were not being resold and (2) resale of that service to non-residential tenants or customers on an individually metered basis, regardless of the tariff's present prohibition against such resale. Also Ordering Clause No. 2 directed that the tariff amendment or riders issued above specify, expressly or by reference, that the submetering option established shall be available throughout the Company's service territory to non-residential customers. This filing complies with this Order.

Also, per Ordering Clause No. 4 the requirements of §66(12)(b) regarding newspaper publication of the filings directed in Clauses 1 and 2 shall be made as directed in this Order.
