Dear Secretary Burgess:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing Statement RDM-7 to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 4 – GAS ("Gas Tariff"). This statement is issued November 21, 2014, to become effective December 1, 2014.

The purpose of this filing is to implement the reconciliation of the Company's gas revenue decoupling mechanism for the period November 1, 2013 through October 31, 2014 ("Rate Year 5") in accordance with General Information Section No. 25, Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") Adjustment, of the Gas Tariff.

The Rate Year 5 cumulative net delivery revenue (over-)/under-collections for Group A and Group B¹ are \$467,256 and \$(236,146), respectively, including interest.

An adjustment was made to correct the reconciliation of prior period November and December estimates. The original estimates for the 2011 and 2012 included a reconciliation of the estimated interest but not the principal balance estimates. In addition, an adjustment was made to the 2012 and 2013 class-specific principal balances for Group A and Group B. The Company inadvertently excluded the prior period (over-)/under-collection in the beginning balances.

Group-specific RDM surcharges have been determined to recover these net delivery revenue shortfalls over the twelve-month period commencing December 1, 2014.

¹ Group A consists of Service Classification No. 1 and Service Classification No. 6 Rate Schedule IA customers. Group B consists of Service Classification No. 2 and Service Classification No. 6 Rate Schedule IB and Rate Schedule II customers.
