**Purpose of Filing**

On January 8, 2014, in accordance with the notice issued November 27, 2013, the Company submitted tariff leaves creating an Agricultural Consumer Electricity Cost Discount to be effective September 1, 2014. This program is available to agricultural producers who receive their electric service at the Company’s residential rate. These leaves were approved by the Commission by Order issued March 4, 2014 with the program and leaves becoming effective September 1, 2014.

After further discussion with PSC Staff, it was determined that further revisions were required to the above leaves to clarify what forms were required from customers to avail themselves of this Residential Agricultural Discount (“RAD”) Program. Rule 42.6.7.1 has been revised to expand the list of forms Staff has determined would qualify customers to qualify for the RAD.

Since the above changes are of a housekeeping/clarifying nature, the Company is respectfully requesting that these changes become effective on 30 days notice, September 15, 2014.

Attachment 1 contains redlined tariff leaves showing where the changes to the above leaves have occurred.

As requested in the filing of January 8, 2014, the Company is respectfully asking for a waiver of the requirements of newspaper publication for this filing as required in 16 NYCRR 720.8 and PSL §66-12 because the Company performed outreach and education channels to reach out to customers after the original filing.

Please advise the undersigned of any action taken regarding this filing.
