The purpose of this filing is of a housekeeping/conforming nature to propose minor revisions to the above leaves. Specifically, the above leaves contain clarifying revisions to Rule No. 42 - Merchant Function Charge ("MFC"). Specifically, the following changes are proposed:

- 1) Leaf 222.1 Rule No. 42.3.3.1 has been revised to more clearly state how the Merchant Function Charge is applied to the Electricity Supply Uncollectible Expense.
- 2) Leaf No. 222.2 Rule No. 42.3.4.1 has also been revised to more clearly state how the Merchant Function Charge is applied to the Working Capital on Purchased Power Costs and to remove the factors from the tariff. The factors in the tariff are redundant since these factors are included in the filed Statement of Merchant Function Charge Statement.

Attachment 1 included with this filing contains redlined leaves to show where the changes to the above leaves have occurred.

Because of the housekeeping/clarifying nature of this filing, waiver of the statutory requirements required under the State Administrative Procedures Act is requested for these leaves to become effective on May 9, 2014.
