**RE: Case 15-E-0082 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the
Policies, Requirements and Conditions for Implementing a Community
Net Metering Program**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The revised Tariff Leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of April 1, 2017:

Reason for Filing

The Commission’s Order Modifying Community Distributed Generation Membership Requirements, issued and effective March 13, 2017, in Case 15-E-0082 (the “Order”) directed each utility to file tariff amendments to remove the ten-member minimum requirement for a Community Distributed Generation (“CDG”) project that serves multiple residential or non-residential customers on its property.

Tariff Change

As directed by the Order, the Company has revised Leaf 249.2 of Rider R – Net Metering for Customer-Generators. Text on that Leaf currently indicates, “The CDG

Host must designate no fewer than ten CDG Satellite Accounts.” The Company has appended to that sentence, “unless all the CDG Satellite Accounts are located on the same property as the CDG Host.”

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing this Tariff change to become effective on April 1, 2017, not less than ten days’ after the Order’s issuance.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
